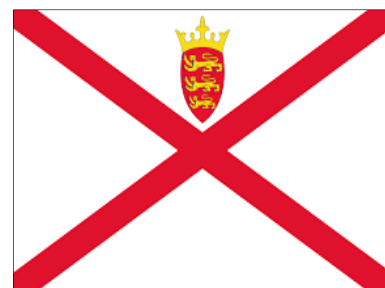
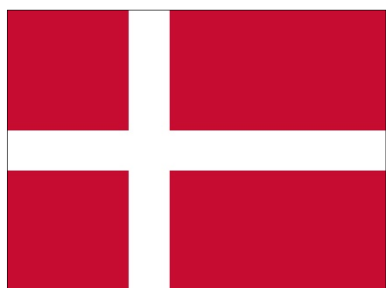

PLAYING RULES

General Rules

FIPJP Official Rules of the Sport of Pétanque (English Translation) as adopted by the FIPJP Executive Committee on the 4 December 2016 at the Congress at Madagascar and applicable from 1 January 2017.

Specific Competition Rules

1. Each Nation may enter 2 triples - Team 1 and Team 2
2. A Triple may consist of 3 or 4 players.
3. Players may not change between Team 1 and Team 2 during the competition.
4. All Teams play against both Teams from every other nation - 10 matches in total.
5. Matches are timed to 50 minutes. When time is up a whistle will sound and the current end should be played until all boules are thrown.
6. If the last boule of an end has been thrown and landed when the 50 minute whistle is blown the next end is deemed to have commenced and must be played out in full.*
7. The Team has one throw of the jack, and if the throw is not valid, the opponent places the jack in a position of their choice – within the rules for throwing a jack.

Scoring

8. Match Points:
 - a. Lost game - 0 Match points
 - b. Tied game - 1 Match point
 - c. Won game (less than 13 points scored) - 2 Match points
 - d. Won game (13 points scored) - 3 Match points
9. Positions are determined in the following order of Priority:

Match Points, Games Won, Points Difference, Points For

** For clarity, if, when the 50 minute whistle sounds, the last boule of the end has been thrown and landed then the next end is deemed to have started regardless of whether the jack has been thrown. The jack must be thrown, and the end played out.*

10. Trophies will be awarded for the Best and 2nd Place Nations **AND** for the Best Triple Team.

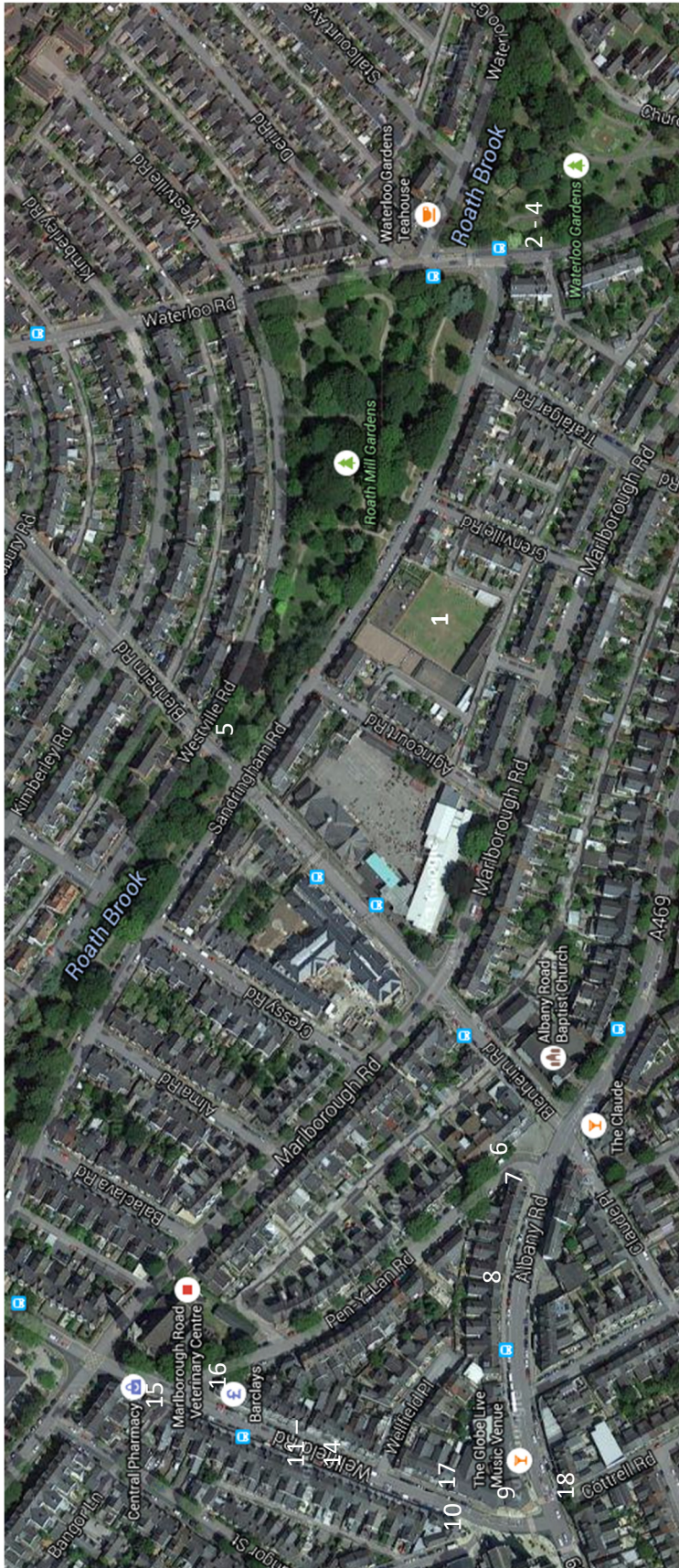
