



SAFE PETANQUE EASY GUIDE



In order to protect everyone's safety and health, Monkstone Petanque Club and the Welsh Petanque Association strongly recommend following the guidelines below. These guidelines apply to everyone who wishes to play petanque

					1. Singles & Doubles ^[1] play, Shooting Practice & Personal Coaching.
					2. Every player disinfects their equipment before and after use.
					3. Disinfect your hands before and after playing.
					4. Each player only uses their equipment and does not touch the other player's equipment.
					5. Each player, when it is their turn, uses their jack.
					6. A throwing circle is not used. The player who starts the game draws a circle on the surface with their foot.
					7. Between two lanes that are played on, two lanes must be left vacant.
					8. Measuring is done by 1 person at a time; each player uses their measure.
					9. Scoreboards must not be used.
					10. At all times the distance of 2 meters between each other will be respected.
					11. Players may wear a mask and follow the instructions for use.
					12. No physical contact is permitted
					13. Players can only sit on clearly designated benches, seating or picnic tables.
					14. After playing you go home immediately.
					15. Everyone uses their common sense to ensure each other's safety.
